WHAT IS INVOLVED?

- 3 interviews about your child's feeding challenges and behaviors
- **24 Weekly 1-hour visits in your home** to work on family feeding goals
- 8 in-home parent training sessions related to feeding
- 2 Visits at the Waisman Center at the beginning and end
- Surveys about your child and family and a 3 day diet record
- Heart rate collected during assessment visits and twice in your home

HOW MUCH TIME WILL IT TAKE?

- All participation will take about **6 months**
- **1 hour per week with a therapist at home**
- Families will be asked to use intervention strategies throughout the week during daily activities like meals and snacks for a total of 10-15 hours each week.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Parents of a child, ages 2-7 years, with a current Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) diagnosis and feeding challenges.
- Parent must live in the same household with the child at least 50% of the time, speak English, and live in Wisconsin.
